IMPORTANT REMINDERS / NEWS



The following are a few updates / reminders we want to share as we get the season started. The Student Handbook will be coming out later this month, however these are a few important things that need to be brought to your attention sooner rather than later:



Parents are allowed in the building again! YEAH! We missed seeing all of your faces while we had to limit the number of people in the building (due to COVID). We are happy to be able to remove this restriction so all parents / guests are allowed to come in to the building if / when needed. That said, please do be conscious and courteous of how much seating space is available in the lobby.



Borrowing Shoes: While The Dance Refinery does have loaner shoes for students to borrow if they forget their dance bags, this should not be a regular occurrence and does not replace the need for you to purchase the appropriate shoes for your classes.

We do appreciate all of the generous donations we have received to keep our loaner shoes well stocked, however we are currently no longer accepting donations.



Are you aware of our dress code? Dress Code requirements can be found in our Fall-Winter-Spring 2022-23 schedule packet (pages 4 - 5). We expect everyone to check the dress code and purchase the correct shoes / attire by Tuesday September 6th.



Building Etiquette: We take great pride in keeping our building clean and looking nice. Please help us keep it that way! Since the session began, we have had to replace the soap dispensers in the girls bathroom 3 times and there was lipstick used to color on a toilet seat. If your child is caught vandalizing the building, we will be seeing you. Please remind them the bathrooms are not play rooms - they need to be in / out quickly.

We also ask that if you are using the tables in the gym viewing area, please clean up your trash when you are finished and please PUSH IN YOUR CHAIR when you are finished so the next guest can use it. We are aware seating space is limited, so please do not leave your belongings on a table or chair while you are in class. Please use the cubbies provided to store your stuff. If you need to stand along the wall in the viewing area, please avoid putting your hands or feet on the walls.



Need a drink of water? The drinking fountains have been re-opened and are again available for use to get a drink or fill a water bottle.



Need to miss a class and / or schedule a make up lesson? If your child is going to be absent from a class, please call (317-881-1905) or email (thedancerefineryin@gmail.com) to notify us of the absence and we can assist you in scheduling a make up lesson (as a reminder, performing group and gymnastics team practices can not be made up).

You must schedule all make up lessons in advance (with the office). This includes students wanting to make up a technique class.

THE DANCE REFINERY - REFERRAL PROGRAM -



- ★ The current student receives a one time \$40 credit on monthly tuition (after the new student has paid in full for two full months of class).
- ★ A new student is defined as one who has NEVER been enrolled at The Dance Refinery. The new student will receive HALF OFF the Registration fee and a one time 10% discount at The Dance Depot.
- ★ In order to receive your credit for the current Fall/Winter/Spring Session, referred students must be registered by April 1st. Due to the short length of the Summer Session, we do not offer the referral program in the Summer. If a new student starts in the summer, we will honor the referral credit when re-enrolling for the next Fall/Winter/Spring session.
- ★ The Referral form MUST be turned in at Registration by the new family. You are allowed only one referral PER NEW FAMILY.
