IMPORTANT REMINDERS / NEWS

The following are a few updates / reminders we want to share as we get the season started!

CLASS VIEWING! Watch Week begins in October! Please refer to the Monthly Newsletter for the viewing schedule! The monthly calendars can be found on the back couple pages of the Newsletter. If you have any questions regarding Watch Week, please visit the front office!



Borrowing Shoes: While The Dance Refinery does have loaner shoes for students to borrow if they forget their dance bags, this should not be a regular occurrence and does not replace the need for you to purchase the appropriate shoes for your classes. Please see the front office if you need to borrow a pair of dance shoes.

We do appreciate all of the generous donations we have received to keep our loaner shoes well stocked, however we are currently no longer accepting donations.



Are you aware of our dress code? Dress Code requirements can be found in our Fall-Winter-Spring 2024-25 schedule packet (pages 4 - 5). We expect everyone to check the dress code and purchase the correct shoes / attire by the end of September! Please remember you have a discount card for The Dance Depot!



Building Etiquette: We take great pride in keeping our building clean and looking nice...help us keep it that way! In the last few years, we have had our bathrooms remodeled, floors re-done, and a fresh coat of paint on the hallway walls. Please remind your children that the bathrooms are not play rooms (they need to be in / out quickly) and to keep hands off the walls. We also ask that students not take food and/or candy into the bathroom to eat.

We also ask that if you are using the tables in the gym viewing area, please clean up your trash when you are finished and please **PUSH IN YOUR CHAIR** when you are finished so the next guest can use it. We are aware seating space is limited, so please do not leave your belongings on a table or chair while you are in class. Please use the cubbies provided to store your stuff. If you need to stand along the wall in the viewing area, **please avoid putting your hands or feet on the walls**.



Need a drink of water? The drinking fountains (in the café area, by the vending machines) are available for use to get a drink or fill a water bottle. If you need to purchase a bottle of water for \$2, please see the office staff.



Need to miss a class and / or schedule a make up lesson? If your child is going to be absent from a class, please call (317-881-1905) or email (thedancerefineryin@gmail.com) to notify us of the absence and we can assist you in scheduling a make up lesson As a reminder, performing group and gymnastics team practices (above pre-team level) can not be made up.

You must schedule all make up lessons in advance (with the office). This includes students wanting to make up a technique class.




If you do not attend a scheduled make-up lesson, you will lose the make-up for that class. Classes are only allowed 2 students to do a make-up lesson each week—by re-scheduling multiple times, you are taking spots from others that may need a make-up lesson!

- ★ A new student is defined as one who has NEVER been enrolled at The Dance Refinery. The new student will receive HALF OFF the Registration fee and a one time 10% discount at The Dance Depot.
- ★ In order to receive your credit for the current Fall/Winter/Spring Session, referred students must be registered by April 1st. Due to the short length of the Summer Session, we do not offer the referral program in the Summer. If a new student starts in the summer, we will honor the referral credit when re-enrolling for the next Fall/Winter/Spring session.
- ★ The Referral form MUST be turned in at Registration by the new family. You are allowed only one referral PER NEW FAMILY.


